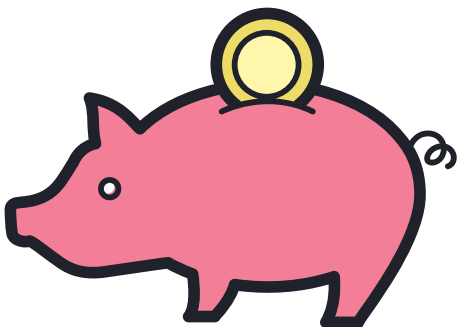
But, first up, what is money and why do we need it?

The Jar Game!

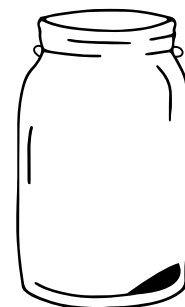
1. Think about something that you would like to buy, like a new book or toy
